Place and date

The Eiscup will be held in Innsbruck at **Tiroler Wasserkraft Arena** (Olympiaworld Innsbruck), Olympiastraße 10, 6020 Innsbruck, **from November 18 to 20, 2022**.
The Ice Rink (30mx60m) is indoor and heated.

General Regulation

The 26th Eiscup Innsbruck will be conducted in accordance with the current ISU Regulations of Figure Skating and respective all pertinent ISU Communications for the categories Seniors, Juniors, Advanced Novice, Intermediate Novice and Basic Novice and in accordance with ÖWO (Österreichische Wettlaufordnung).

CATEGORIES

SENIOR LADIES & MEN

In accordance with ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 611, paragraphs 1-3, and Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communications. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec

Free Skating: 4 min 00 sec, +/- 10 sec

JUNIOR LADIES & MEN

In accordance with ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 611, paragraphs 1-3, and Rule

612 and the respective ISU Communications. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.

Short Program: Max 2 min 40 sec, +/-10 sec

Free Skating: 3 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

Age and requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, ISU Communication 2489 and all respective ISU Communications.

Short Program: Max 2 min 20 sec, +/-10sec

Free Skating: 3 min +/-10 sec

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements: Intermediate Novice skater is who was born: 1.7.2007 and younger.

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, ISU Communication 2489 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 3 min, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements: Basic Novice skater is who was born: 1.7.2009 and younger.

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2022, ISU Communication 2489 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

CUBS GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements – Cubs is a skater who was born: 1.7.2012 – 30.6.2014 (minimum 8 and not 10)

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

CHICKS GIRLS & BOYS

Age requirements - Chicks Skater is a skater who was born: 1.7.2014 and younger (not 8)

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well balanced Free Skating program for Chicks & Cubs Singles Boys + Girls must contain:

a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combinations can contain only two (2) jumps. Any single or double jump may be executed only twice in total. Triple jumps are not permitted.

b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation). Flying Entry is allowed.

c) There must be a maximum one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only. The step sequence must cover at least half of the ice surface to be counted.

The Program Components are only judged in

- Composition
- Presentation
- Skating Skills

The Factor of the Program Components is 1.67

Deductions (e.g. falls, time violation): -0,5

Levels explanations:

In all elements which are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

ENTRIES

- **Clubs from Austria** have to register skaters for Eiscup via **Skate Austria Portal** latest by **October 31, 2022**. If the category differs to your national category, please contact thomas.biegler@skateaustria.at
- **Clubs from all other countries** must send the entry forms for their skaters latest by **October 31, 2022** to:

Entry lists, competition schedules, competition results will be published at the Sportity-App. The organizing committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries due to limited ice availability and in accordance with any upcoming COVID-19 regulations. If the limit is reached we will close the entry list and offer further skaters to be put on the waiting list. Entries will be on first come first serve principle. Those skaters who have not paid their entry fees till the entry fee deadline will be replaced by skaters next on the waiting list.

In very special cases we may offer reimbursement also later (medical attests need to be sent along with withdrawals).

The uploaded/sent music files must show competitor's name, nationality, category, program (short/free skating).

We highly recommend to send the music files very soon after confirmation of participation. This will give us time to check compatibility of the music and to contact participating clubs if problems should arise.

Victory ceremonies for Juniors and Seniors will be held on ice or off ice at the end of the competition along with price ceremony for the winners of Cup of Innsbruck. Due to the strict COVID-19 regulations we can only award gold, silver and bronze medalists of each category this year at the price ceremonies.
