GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Cup of Innsbruck 2025 International Competition in Single and Pair Skating will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications.

All Members of the ISU are invited to take part in the competition. Competitors participating in Senior, Junior and Advanced Novice categories must be entered through their respective Member Federation. Younger categories please see the separate Interclub Competition announcement for "Eiscup 2025".

Participation is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

ENTRIES

Each ISU Member can enter up to three (3) skaters/couples in each category. Preference will be given to those ISU Members which sent entries by number, in order of receipt of such entries. A waiting-list will be kept up to date daily. In case of too many entries, the organizer may reduce the final entries.

All Entries must be made by the ISU Member concerned through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by the deadline indicated.

With the online entry the "Program Content Sheet" must also be filled out in the ISU Portal. It is not permitted to hand over the Program Content Sheets directly to the acting Officials.

Entries by number

The preliminary entries must reach the Organizer by latest:

September 18, 2025 – 20:00 h (CET) by entering the information through the ORS.

Entries by name

The Entries by names must be done through the ORS not later than October 16, 2025 – 20:00 h (CET).

Entry fee

Single Skating EUR 125,00

Pair Skating EUR 175,00

Payment deadline (payment must be received on the Organizing Committees bank account by): October 20, 2025

Banking fees must be covered by the payer.

Late Entry Fee (for registrations after the entry deadline and/or payments after the payment deadline)

Single Skating EUR 135,00

Pair Skating EUR 185,00

Entries will only be confirmed if the entry fee is paid by bank transfer by October 30, 2025.

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals.

Payment must be made in one transfer per member federation for all entered skaters.

Entries of Judges

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one ISU or International Judge and one substitute Judge.

The Entries of Judges must be done through the ORS no later than October 16, 2025.

Each panel of Judges will consist of 5 judges. In case of a too high number of entered Judges, the Organizing Committee will make a draw and inform ISU Members by October 20, 2025, whether Judges have been drawn or not drawn.

Draw for starting order

The draw will be held online on Wednesday November 12, until 12.00 (CET) in presence of one of the Referees, in accordance with Rule 512 and 513 of the ISU Constitution and General Regulations. Competitors/official representatives are welcome to be present in person.

The draw can also be followed via the livestream.

The starting order for the Free Skating shall be based on the reverse order of the result of the Short Program.

Officials

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for Judges and invited officials taking part, beginning on November 12, 2025, (dinner) and ending on November 16, 2025, (lunch) in accordance with their travel plans and scheduled activities.

If any judge or invited official arrive at the hotel before, or stay longer after the period described above, their hotel costs are at their own risk and must be paid on arrival.

All additional charges incurred by an official/judge are at their own charge and must be paid prior to departure.

PRACTICE

The official practices for competitors start on November 12, 2025 / appr. 08:00. The detailed schedule will be published in the Sportity app. There is also unofficial practise ice available. This schedule will also be published in the Sportity app in time.

MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT / PRESS FORMS

Music

All competitors shall offer competition music of excellent quality on MP3, M4A or WAV format, following Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations, paragraph 2. A list of titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Program for Single and Pairs, must be entered on the ISU Portal.

The Music files must be labelled with the following data:

1. Name of the ISU Member.
2. Category
3. Segment
4. Name of the competitor

Example:

The competition music, only MP3, M4A or WAV format, must be sent to innsbruck@skateaustria.events before the entry deadline of October 16, 2025.

Competitors must provide a backup drive (USB stick) for each program. This USB stick must also be labelled with all mentioned data. CD's will not be accepted by the OC.

Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.

If music information is not complete and provided as mentioned, accreditation will not be given.

PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT & PRESS FORMS.

The Planned Program Content, Music and Press forms must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform before the entry deadline. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

Accreditation

The accreditation office is located at the ice rink. Accreditation will be given to each official, skater, 1 coach per skater, 1 team leader per ISU member plus 1 chaperone per skater (only for Advanced Novice).

Results

The marking system (ISU Figure Skating Manager) as described in ISU Special Regulations Single and Pair Skating 2024, Rule 352 will be in place.

Award Ceremony

The award ceremony will take place at the end of the competition according to the schedule. All skaters will be awarded. The trophy „**Internationaler Pokal der Stadt Innsbruck**“ („**International Cup of Innsbruck**“) will be awarded to the skaters with the **highest total score** (Senior Pairs, Women or Men).

SPORTITIY APP

The Sportity-app can be downloaded via Google Playstore or Apple App Store. All relevant competition information will be published on the App (incl. Entries & Results). There will be no information boards on site and all participants are kindly asked to use the App instead.

LIVESTREAM

A livestream of the Competition is provided via Solidsport. By entering the competition, each person agrees on recordings and/or transmissions (e.g. via the internet, TV) of his/her/their performance, appearance, picture, voice, or other personal characteristics displayed in connection with the event, towards an unrestricted audience and without temporal or geographical limits.

GDPR

By entering all participants accept that personal data are collected by the Organizing Committee (OC) and such data are stored and used by the OC and when necessary, third parties, for the purposes only of and to the extent necessary only in relation to facilitate their participation in the competition. Personal data may include but will not be limited to full legal name as per national identity documents, address, date of birth, nationality, gender.

INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each member participating in the Cup of Innsbruck, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance. The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.
